Tidy up - Protect

CLOSED ROPE BAGS



The closed rope bags have been developed to stow lines coiled. Once the line is coiled, pull the front of the rope bag to open, slide the coil inside. The rope bag closes automatically.

No matter what the conditions are the line is always there.

Pull, stow and let go. It's shut!

All the Outils Ocean rope bags have our quick fixation system, which allows for easy installation and removal.

WINCH HANDLE HOLDERS



The Outils Oceans winch handle holders have one or two inclined cut-outs on the upper part to allow the winch handle to always be arranged against the boat. The winch handle holder with 2 cut-outs is universal, allowing the winch handle to be stored in all cases, to the left or to the right. The pair of winch handle holders, clockwise rotation (left) and anticlockwise rotation (right), permit you to choose the direction the winch handle will be stored, to the right or to the left, in respect to winch or a bulk head. The pairs of clockwise and counterclockwise rotating allow you to choose the direction of rotation in relation to an object (bitt, bulkhead, door) and the location of the winch.

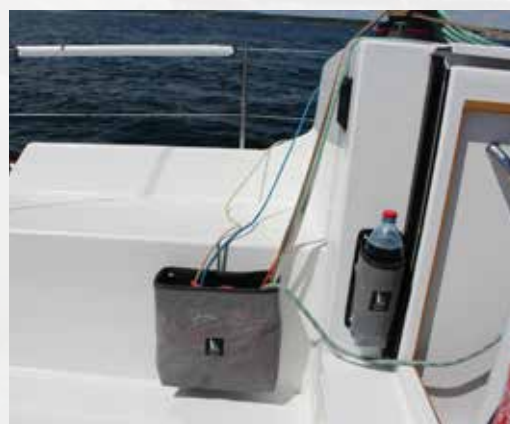

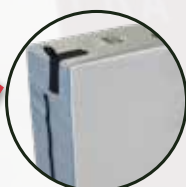

Tips for using MAGIC-REBOARD®

The small rope allows the ladder to be opened unaided from the water. The ladder unfolds automatically.

The length of the ladder is adapted for most boats on the market today. The steps of the ladder have been specially designed to sink into the water. In order to easily reboard there should be 4 steps in the water.

Reboarding is facilitated with wide steps to allow both feet on the steps at the same time and a reasonable distance between the steps to make climbing easier.

In conformity with the Norm EN/ISO 15085 and the European Directive 2013/53/EU, it adapts to all types and sizes of boats. Easy to install, cow hitch the reboarding ladder around the stern rail.

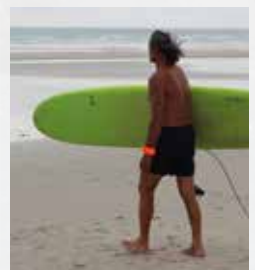

The Magic-Mât ladder is the simplest solution for climbing the mast alone.

Alternating rungs and a polyethylene-lined 'platform' at the top ensure optimum comfort and safety. The ladder comes in lengths of 3, 7 or 9 metres and is delivered in a large storage bag. It is designed to be extended (2, 3 and 7 metres) to adapt to the height of your mast. You can do all kinds of work on your mast, including changing a light, working on the spreader bars and attaching a windvane, thanks to the safety kit: work harness and fall arrestor.

The use of a harness and a fall arrest device (Outils Océans or another manufacturer) is **mandatory** for safety: the fall arrest device attaches to a free halyard which serves as your lifeline **and** to the harness.

Tips for using MAGIC-MAT®



Attach the mainsail, spinnaker or genoa halyard to the eye at the top of the mast ladder (the side where there are two steps facing).
Hoist the halyard with the mast ladder.
Remove the twists.



Attach the eye at the bottom to the gooseneck or a fitting on the mast.
Tension the halyard.

To climb :

- hands around the mast,
- feet against the mast, push your body against your feet, once to the right and once to the left and so on. This requires a slight rotation of the body around the mast.



When the right foot pushes on the mast, you're on the right side of the mast, when the left foot pushes

At the masthead, wedge your feet in the steps, your back is supported by the harness, and both your hands are free to work.

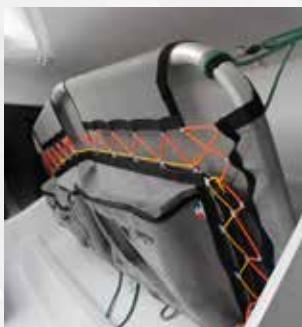
